Spring Assessment

Spring Assessments (including MStep, PSAT, and SAT) will take place at the Academy over the next several weeks. **On April 11 and 12, students will have half days** and additional details regarding assignments and dismissal time will be coming soon. All students will participate in assessments or other learning activities on the half days. Due to the specific timing of each assessment, we can provide a good estimate of dismissal times, but please be patient with us!

- 2) 11th grade students will participate in the SAT and WorkKeys Assessments. These will be the longest assessments and Juniors will be dismissed around noon both days.
- 3) 10th, 9th, and Middle School students will be dismissed at approximately 11:50 both days.
