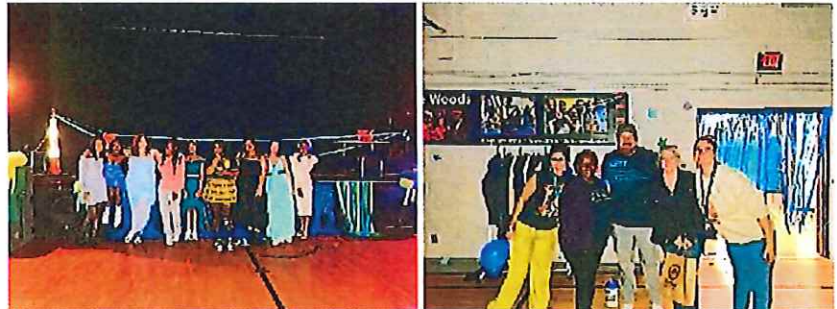

Don't believe everything you hear, be more assertive, and talk to an adult. Use "I" statements and use a calm tone. Take deep breaths and use fidgets, just try and communicate how you're feeling.
